MANUSCRIPT REQUIREMENTS:

Manuscripts must be between 5 and 20 pages, in APA format, that is between 3000 and 8000 words, excluding references.

PLAGIARISM CHECK:

Submissions are invariably checked for plagiarism.

All submitted manuscripts will undergo rigorous peer review by experts in the respective fields. We are committed to maintaining the highest standards of scholarly integrity and excellence.

PUBLICATION ETHICS:

Authors of accepted papers will be required to sign an Author Agreement with the journal publishers, MBMC, upon acceptance.
