- Length: Within 300 words.
- Language: English or Nepali.
- Content: Should include the title, author's name(s), affiliation(s), contact information, background, research objectives, methodology, key findings, and relevance to the conference theme.
- Format: Follow APA 7th edition for citations and references.

Full Papers

- Length: 4,000–8,000 words.
- Language: English or Nepali.
- Format: Follow APA 7th edition for citations and references.

- Poster Presentations: Visual display of research findings, with designated times for discussion.

- International participants are welcome.
