Upon submission, the college RMC will schedule evaluation meeting for the short listed proposals with a short notice between 3 to 7 days. Budget for a project may be allocated up to 50 thousands for individual mini research project and it may be granted up to 2 lakhs for collective project depending upon nature of research, significance, student's involvement and faculty across discipline engagement. The duration will be up to 6 months which may be changed subject to evaluation committee. The maximum 5 projects will be selected for grants.

The faculty members are encouraged to involve students in their proposed research works.
