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BCA Program

Tribhuvan University (TU) has launched Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA) program under Faculty of Humanities and Social Science having 4 years (8 semester) degree from the academic year 2074/75. In the first phase, it was launched to six constituent campuses and later to 125 affiliated campuses of TU all over Nepal with 35 students seat capacity each. After office of the Vice Chancellor of TU planned 4 years BCA program, many colleges showed interest to run this program. Besides Purbanchal University and Pokhara University are also running this program. This program is similar to other programs like Bsc.CSIT, B.Ed.ICT, BIM etc. Students who have passed PCL or +2 or equivalent level securing minimum 40% marks or 2 CGPA (not less than D+ in each subject) are eligible for admission in BCA program of TU. BCA graduates can seek their career as system analysts, system managers, project managers, database administrator, system designer and as programmers in Information industries, Manufacture industries and IT companies. After completion of this degree, students are further eligible to study in any faculty under Management and Information Technology, such as, MCA, MIT, MIM, MBA and many more.

Students Data

As MBMC offers vast array of faculties and streams for students to choose, a total of 984 students are currently studying in the college. Students ranging from Higher secondary to Masters Degree are studying in this very institution. As the number goes, there are 219 students studying in grade 11 which is further divided into three streams as Science, Humanities and Management which again consist of 41,65 and 113 students respectively. In grade XII 47, 35, and 103 students are studying science, Humanities and Management respectively, that comes to be 185 in total. As for the Bachelors program there are total of 191 students in first year, where 67,61, 15 and 48 students are studying BA, BBS, BCA and BScCSIT respectively. Similarly, in the second year 62,43 and 46 students are studying BBS, BA and CSIT respectively whereas in the third year there are 36,32 and 46 students are studying BBS, BA and CSIT. In the fourth year 42 students are studying BBS and 45 students are studying CSIT. Likewise, In Masters level there are 10 students studying MA-JMC, 2nd semester and 9 students are there in the 3rd one. In Sociology 2nd semester, there are 11 students are studying and 7 students are in MA English, 3rd Semester.
