- The arrival time is 15 minutes before commencement of exam. Students will not be considered in exam hall after 15 minutes of commencement time.
- Mobile, Laptop, Programming Calculator, any electronic devices or any type of reading materials are strictly prohibited in exam.
- Students must bring their belongings (like pen, pencil, sharpener, eraser, calculator, ruler or any things) by themselves. It is strictly prohibited to use other's belongings during exam.
- Everyone is responsible to create the exam environment peaceful. Students can draw invigilator's attention just
 by standing up to request anything they require such as additional answer sheets, water, short leave, depart
 from exam etc.
- Students cannot leave exam hall during first hour. Students may take a short leave for maximum five minutes
 within second and third hour of exam but students cannot take short leave during the last 30 minutes of exam
 time.
