Tribhuvan University has launched four-year bachelor's course in BA from the academic year 2076/077 under the faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences.

Bachelor of Arts is an inter-disciplinary subjects' course where students at MBMC can study Compulsory

English, Sociology, Major English, Social Work, and Mass Communication within the same stream. The four-year course is of 2,000 marks (500 marks each year) and students can choose two subjects of 700 marks each as their majors and two subjects of 100 marks each as elective subjects.

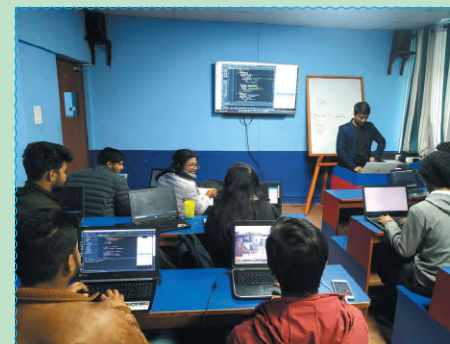
## BCA (Bachelor of Computer Application)
